

Statute of the Prof. Janusz M. Rosiak Award

1. The Professor Janusz M. Rosiak Award, hereinafter referred to as the Award, is granted by the Polish company BioMatGel Sp. z o. o. (BMG) with its registered office in Łódź for an original achievement in research in the field of polymers and ionizing radiation, in particular radiation engineering of polymeric biomaterials, in the scope of basic and applied research, in which ionizing radiation is used to produce, modify or sterilize polymer biomaterials.
2. The Award is granted annually in the form of a diploma and a cash prize. The amount of the award is determined each time by the BMG Board.
3. The Award is granted for a poster presentation during conferences presenting the achievement in the scope specified in point 1.
4. The Award may be received by an university student, a doctoral student, and a person at the initial stage of a career up to 35 years of age, a Polish or a foreigner.
5. Active participation in the international Ionizing Radiation and Polymers (IRaP) Conference, held every two years, is the necessary condition for receiving the Award. In years when the aforementioned conference is not held, active participation in the Masters and PhD Students Session of the Łódź Chemistry Community (SMiDŁŚCh) is the necessary condition.
6. The selection of the achievement is made by the Prize Committee (PC), consisting of at least two persons with education, function and/or experience allowing for a substantive selection of the achievement.
7. The BMG Board, or a Member of the BMG Board, or a person authorized by the BMG Board, present at the aforementioned IRaP or SMiDŁŚCh conferences, appoints persons to the PC and designates from among them a chairman, who prepares a report on the assessment of the achievements. The PC may be appointed remotely by the BMG Board.
8. The decision of the PC on the prize winner is irreversible and cannot be appealed.
9. The award is presented to the winner during the aforementioned conference by a representative of BMG and/or by the PC.
10. BMG reserves the right not to award the Prize without giving a reason.
